

10th Sunday After Pentecost (Tone 1)
Afterfeast of the Transfiguration
1 Corinthians 4: 9 – 16 **Matthew 17: 14 – 23**

Beatitude Verses
6 from Octoechos for Resurrection
4 from Festal Menaion Ode 3 for Transfiguration

People: In Your kingdom remember us, O Lord, when You come into Your kingdom.

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted!

Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth!

Reader: The enemy lead Adam out of Paradise through food; but by the Cross, Christ has led back to Paradise the Wise Robber who cried: Remember me when You come into Your kingdom!

People: Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled!

Reader: With Adam and the Wise Robber, I venerate Your suffering and glorify Your resurrection; and I cry out with a splendid voice: Remember me when You come into Your kingdom!

People: Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy!

Reader: O Sinless Lord, of Your own will You were crucified and placed in the tomb, yet You arose as God, raising up also Adam who cries out: Remember me when You come into Your kingdom!

People: Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God!

Reader: O Christ God, raising up the temple Your body by Your resurrection on the third day, You raised up Adam and his descendants who cry: Remember me when You come into Your kingdom!

People: Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God!

Reader: O Christ God, the myrrh-bearing women arrived very early, weeping at Your tomb, and they found an angel sitting there, clothed in white garments who said: What are you searching for? Christ is risen! Do not lament any longer!

People: Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven!

Reader: O Savior, when Your apostles went to the mountain where You had commanded them to go, they worshipped You; and You sent them to the nations, to teach and baptize them.

People: Blessed are you when people revile you, persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for my sake!

Reader: The Savior illumined us on Tabor as the shining Light which is far brighter than the sun.

People: Rejoice, and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven!

Reader: O Christ, having ascended Mount Tabor, You were transfigured; and by having cast falsehood utterly into darkness, You have illumined us.

People: **Glory** to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Reader: How great and awesome was the vision seen this day! From the sky the material sun shone forth, while from the earth the spiritual Sun of righteousness, which is beyond compare, shone forth on Mount Tabor.

People: **Now** and ever, and to the ages of ages. Amen.

Reader: O Christ, seeing Your divinity, Moses cried out on Tabor, “The shadow of the Law has grown weak and has passed away, and Christ the Truth has revealed Himself to us!”

Resurrection Troparion Tone 1

People:
When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, /
And the soldiers were guarding Your immaculate Body. /
You rose on the third day O Saviour, /
Granting Life to the world. /
Therefore the Heavenly Powers cried to You O Giver-of-Life: /
Glory to Your Resurrection O Christ, //
Glory to Your Kingdom, //
Glory to Your Dispensation, O only Lover-of-mankind!

**Troparion of the Transfiguration of Christ
Tone 7**

People:

O Christ our God, You were transfigured on the mountain, /
showing to Your disciples Your glory as far as they could endure. /
Let Your eternal light also shine on us sinners, /
through the prayers of the Theotokos, //
O Giver of light, glory to You.

People: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion of the Transfiguration of Christ
Tone 7**

People:

O Christ God You were transfigured on the mountain, /
and Your disciples, saw Your glory, /
as much as they could endure; /
so that when they would see You being crucified, /
they would know that You suffered willingly, /
and they would preach to the world //
that You are truly the Radiance of the Father.

People: Now and ever and to the ages of ages. Amen.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection
Tone 1**

People:

As God, You arose from the tomb in glory, /
And You raised the world together with Yourself. /
Mortal nature praises You as God, /
And death is vanished. /
Now Adam exults, O Master, /
Eve rejoices, being freed from chains, and cries: /
Glory to You O Christ our God, //
Who grants resurrection to all.

**Resurrection Prokeimenon
Tone 1**

Deacon: Let us attend.

Priest: Peace be to all.

Reader: And to your spirit.

Deacon: Wisdom!

Reader: The Prokeimenon in the 1st Tone: Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, just as we hope in You.

People: Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, just as we hope in You.

Reader: Rejoice greatly in the Lord, O righteous ones; praise is fitting for the upright.

People: Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, just as we hope in You.

Reader: Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us.

People: Just as we hope in You.

Deacon: Wisdom!

Reader: The Reading is from the First Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians.

Deacon: Let us attend.

Epistle

Reader: **1 Corinthians 4: 9 – 16**

Priest: Peace be to you the reader.

Reader: And to your spirit.

Deacon: Wisdom!

Alleluiarion Tone 1

Reader: Alleluia in the 1st Tone.

People: Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

Reader: The God who vindicates me, and who subdued the peoples under me.

People: Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

Reader: He who magnifies the salvation of His king and shows mercy to His anointed, to David and his seed forever.

People: Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

Gospel

Deacon: Bless Master, him who proclaims the Holy Gospel of the Holy, Apostle and Evangelist Matthew.

Priest: May God, through the intercessions of the holy, glorious, all praised Apostle and Evangelist Matthew, enable you to proclaim the Good News with great power, for the fulfillment of the Gospel of His Beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.

Deacon: Amen.

Priest: Wisdom! Arise! Let us listen to the Holy Gospel. Peace be to all.

People: And to your spirit.

Deacon: The Reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Saint Matthew.

People: Glory to You, O Lord, glory to You.

Priest: Let us attend.

Deacon: **Matthew 17: 14 – 23**

People: Glory to You, Lord, glory to You.

The Hymn to the Theotokos

Or the Magnification (Megalyrnarion) of the Feast

Instead of "It is truly right..." we sing the Irmos of the 9th Ode of the First Canon of the Transfiguration:

Tone 4

Refrain

Magnify, O my soul, the Lord transfigured on Tabor.

Irmos

O Theotokos, your birthgiving was undefiled: God came forth from your womb, and He appeared upon earth wearing flesh and made His dwelling among men; therefore we all magnify you.

Communion Verse (Koinonikon)

People:

Resurrection: Praise the Lord in the heavens, praise Him in the highest!

Transfiguration: O Lord, we shall walk in the light of Your face, and shall greatly rejoice in Your name the whole day long.
